Contest Rules

- 1. There will be no pre-registration and there will be no prize money. Ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners. Ribbons may be picked up at the tent following judging on Tuesday, August 19th until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 24th when the Fair closes.
- 2. All entries are to be registered and received at the Agricultural Tent on Tuesday, August 19th (the day before the fair starts) from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Exhibitor's name may not appear on the entry, only on the exhibitor card. Judging will begin at 3:00 p.m.
- 3. Exhibits must be called for by the exhibitor Sunday, August 24th at 5:00 p.m. Those exhibits still present after 5:30 p.m. will be forfeited by the owner and disposed of.
- 4. All articles must be raised and owned by the exhibitor. All entries must have a variety of name on tags. All articles must have been produced in New Jersey. Any item incorrectly entered will be disqualified at the judge's discretion.
- 5. Any entries unfit to show will be disqualified.
- 6. After the exhibits are arranged, they will be under exclusive charge of the fair committee and not even the owner shall have the right to remove them until the exhibit is closed. The management may at any time remove an exhibit which is in bad condition.
- 7. A card containing the name and address of the exhibitor may be attached to the exhibit after it has been judged. No printed or written material advertising spray mixtures or implements of any kind will be allowed.
- 8. All classes are open to all exhibitors, but subject to the above rules and regulations.

All entries must be grown by the exhibitor this year, in New Jersey. No variety distinction in classes except where name is mentioned. Produce should be of a reasonable quality for judging.
